## Metal Scrap regulations for India

## Summary: List of destinations permitting scrap imports and instructions

Scrap was a banned commodity into India in 2004; however, in end 2005, customs allowed scrap imports into the below locations/ICDs with proper certifications.

Currently scrap imports are permitted at the following locations/ICDs served by ESL.

- 1. Please note that metal scrap exports from Bandar Abbas (Iran) are NOT permitted in India.
- 2. We need to submit a separate manifest/list for the scrap to the Terminal prior discharging and a proper sub manifest to be filled with the Customs prior rail out of the scrap imports.

The pre-inspection certificate from the origin is a must for Customs & Concor (rail) in India. Please ensure that this is sent to the POD along with the manifest B/L.

- 3. Need following documents from customer prior acceptance of any scrap: -
- a) Copy of valid license issued by DGFT (Director General of Foreign Trade) for importing concern scrap.
- b) Copy of valid license issued by MOEF (Ministry of Environment and Forest)
- 4. As a company we accept only bundled and NOT loose scrap.
